

MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION
OF
SHRI KRISHNA PRANAMI DHARMA SABHA

1. The name of the society

SHRI KRISHNA PRANAMI DHARMA SABHA

(Hereinafter for brevity's sake called Dharma Sabha)

2. Registered office of the society

Registered office and Head Office of the Society shall be at SHRI KRISHNA PRANAMI MANDIR, Dal Bahadur Giri Road (Rishi Road), Post Office – Police Station and Sub Division Kalimpong, District, West Bengal, India, Pin – 734301.

3. Objective for which the society is established are :

- (a) to propagate, develop, strengthen and uphold SHRI KRISHNA PRANAMI DHARMA as propounded & laid by its founders Sataguru Shri Devchandraj Maharaj and Mahatma Shri Prannanathji and the path followed by Guruji Shri 108 Mangaldasji.
- (b) to promote amongst members of SHRI KRISHNA PRANAMI DHARMA true devotion, selfless love, affection and faith towards Lord Shri Krishna.
- (c) to extend cordial relationship with other sister organizations of Sri Krishna Pranami Samaj and to foster & develop religious and social works.
- (d) to maintain and foster friendly relationship with other religious- social organization and institutions.
- (e) to establish and develop Pranami Mandirs, Satsang Kendras, Training institutions/ camps, old age homes, gausalas, dharmshalas, health centers, dispensaries, hospitals, and other benevolent organizations within the jurisdiction of Dharma Sabha.
- (f) to open branch offices of Shri Krishna Pranami Dharma Sabha in various places where Pranami people live.
- (g) to unify Pranami people irrespective of sex and caste and to foster and promote amongst them true love and affection.
- (h) to help and assist any other religious, social and cultural organizations.
- (i) to publish religious books, magazines, periodicals, newspapers etc regarding Pranami Dharma.
- (j) to organise, stage and produce any drama, plays, video films, television serials, feature films and documentaries on Pranami Dharma.
- (k) to receive subscriptions, donation, gifts, whether movable or immovable from Indians or foreign nationals admissible under the laws of Central and State Government of India.
- (l) to educate general people on principles of " Ahimsha Paramodharma".
- (m) to propagate and promote Shri Krishna Pranami Dharma amongst the people by observing good moral, spiritual, educational conduct and standards.
- (n) to foster and promote pure and simple vegetarian way of life for each Pranami.

(o) to construct and establish Pranami Mandirs, Dhams and to provide for daily puja, Arati, Prayers, Bhajans, Satsang etc.

(p) to organize and conduct religious meetings (Sabha), gatherings (sammelan), seminars (sangosthi), discourses and preachings (prabachan) like "Gyan Yagya", "Saptah Puran", Parayan and the "vani" of Nijananda Acharya Sri Devchandra Ji and Mahamati Prannath Ji.

(q) to provide safety & security to all voluntary religious workers of Dharma Sabha like Acharya, Santa, Mahanta, Brahmachari, Grihasthi, and all associated with the works of Shri Krishna Pranami Dharma.

(r) to organize and participate in religious and social activities by maintaining friendly and cordial relationship with other organizations of Hinduism.

(s) to establish, organize, maintain, manage and maintain religious libraries and to collect and preserve religious books and scriptures.

(t) to acquire, hold, possess, dispose and transfer by sale otherwise any movable or immovable property for the purpose of Shri Krishna Pranami Dharma Sabha.

(u) to render necessary relief, rehabilitation works and help to the mankind on compassionate humanitarian grounds during times of any act of God, natural calamities like famine, landslide, flood, earthquake etc.

(v) to bring awareness amongst Pranami people regarding protection and preservation of environment.

(w) to open schools, colleges and other educational institutions for formal and non formal education.

(x) to obtain knowledge and information on agriculture, industry, business etc and to disseminate and impart such knowledge and information for the welfare and benefit of the society.

(y) to do all other acts, deeds and things, for upliftment of moral, social and religious welfare, peace and happiness of entire mankind in true with time and circumstances on the basis of the teachings of sataguru Sri Devachandra Ji and Mahamati Prannath Ji.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS OF
SHRI KRISHNA PRANAMI DHARMA SABHA**

RULE 1 NOMENCLATURE & ADDRESS

- (a) Name of the society shall be 'SHRI KRISHNA PRANAMI DHARMA SABHA'.
(b) The head office of the society shall be at Sri Krishna Pranami Mandir, Dal Bahadur Giri Road (Rishi Road), post office- Police Station and Sub Division Kalimpong District Darjeeling West Bengal, India, Pin 734301.

RULE 2 MEMBERSHIPS

Membership of Shri Krishna Pranami Dharma Sabha can be obtained as follows:

- (a) Any person who has attained the age of 18 years, who is a pure vegetarian, free from intoxicants or drugs, and a Pranami, may be an ordinary member on payment of stipulated membership fee for a period of three years.
(b) Each member shall have a voting rights in each of committee he/she belongs to
(c) There shall be three types of members:
(i) Branch Committee Member.
(ii) Central Committee Member.
(iii) Central Executive Committee Member.
(d) Membership Fee.
Every member admitted into membership shall:
(i) Pay an admission fee of Rs. 5.00 only.
(ii) Pay monthly subscription at the rate of Rs. 2.00 only.
(iii) Submit an application showing his/ her name, address and particular which for all purpose be deemed to be his/ her residence.

(V)

- (a) To maintain accounts of Dharma Sabha.
- (b) To maintain true and current income and expenditure and books of accounts of Dharma Sabha.
- (c) To prepare, have the accounts audited, and prepare balance sheet every year by competent auditor or chartered accountant.

RULE 4

COMMITTEE

COMMITTEES OF DHARMA SABHA

There shall be following three types of committees of Dharma Sabha:

(i) **BRANCH COMMITTEE**

At the root level, 51 (fifty one) or more members residing in a particular locality may open and form Branch Committee of Dharma Sabha with office bearers directly elected by the members in an annual general meeting consisting of one President, one Vice President, one Vice President, one General Secretary, Two Assistant Secretaries, one Treasurer and 6 executive members.

Powers Function and obligation of Branch Committee:

- (a) Look after and maintain local Mandir, Satsang Kendra and other sister organization within the Jurisdiction of Branch Committee.
- (b) Branch Committee shall always strive its best to protect, preserve, manage, maintain and develop its existing as well as acquire new movable and immovable properties within its limits for the purposes and objects of Dharma Sabha.
- (c) Refer and send unresolved & indirected disputed matters to control Committee or control Executive Committee through its representatives.
- (d) Branch Committee shall be fully responsible for regular Seva Puja, Arati, and also for the celebration of the festivals at local level.

(ii) **CENTRAL COMMITTEE**

There shall be one Central Committee as an apex body of Dharma Sabha. It will consist of:

- (a) All presidents and Secretaries and their 2(two) nominee from each Branch Committee. Any Branch Committee having more than 100 members will nominate 3(three) nominees and those having more than 200 members will nominate 4(four) nominees to Central Committee.
- (b) Acharya/Guruji.
- (c) Six nominees of Acharya.

It will exercise following powers, functions and obligations:

- (a) Elect Central Executive members from amongst the members of Central Committee.
- (b) Decide and resolve the matters referred by Central Executive Committees.
- (c) Consider and take necessary actions on the reports of various Branch Committees.
- (d) Do all such acts, deeds and things as may be deemed fit and proper of the purposes of Dharma Sabha.

(iii) **CENTRAL EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:**

Central Executive Committee will consist of 21 (twenty one) members as follows:

- (a) Officiating Acharya of Kalimpong 1
- (b) Elected members from Central Committee 14
- (c) Nominated members by Acharya 6

Executive Committee of Central Committee shall elect the Office Bearers of Central Committee of Dharma Sabha Consisting of one President, one Vice President, one General Secretary, one Treasurer, Two Assistant Secretaries.

Central Executive Committee may be extended by adding more members from time to time. However, convenience and quorum shall be taken into consideration while new executive members are to be added.

Powers, functions, obligation:

- (a) The Central Executive Committee shall look after all workings of Dharma Sabha within its Jurisdiction. It will also after and coordinate the working of all Pranami Mandirs, Sisters organization & various Committees.
- (b) It will resolve any dispute regarding movable and immovable properties of Dharma Sabha.
- (c) It will hear, decide and resolve any complaints raised against any Dharma Pracharak or to resolve and decide any dispute regarding character, discipline, conduct and activities
- (d) It will grant permission for propagation of Pranami Dharma to various Dharma Pracharak, transfer or depute any of them in any place within its jurisdiction.
- (e) It will be the sole responsibility of Central Executive Committee to restrain or stop any Dharma Pracharak whose acts, deeds and things are prejudicial or against the established philosophy, principles, code of conduct of Pranami Dharma.
- (f) In the event Central Executive Committee fails or neglects or finds difficulties in deciding the matters referred in (a) to (i) above the same shall be referred to Central Committee after taking advice from Advisory Board for taking final decision.

RULE 5

TENURE

- (a) Central Committee, Central Executive Committee and Branch Committee of Dharma Sabha shall hold office for a period of 3 (three) years.
- (b) One month prior to expiry of 3 years tenure, the outgoing Committee shall take necessary steps for the constitution of new committee.
- (c) The new committee shall assume office through its office bearers as soon as it is constituted hanging over and taking over of accounts & documents etc. Shall be completed by the respective outgoing and new office bearers within 15 days from date of constitution of a new committee.

RULE 6

(1) Annual General Meeting:

- (1) Annual General Meeting shall be held once a year during the festival of "FAGUPURNIMA" AT Kalimpong as follows:

- (a) Supreme authority of Shri Krishna Pranami Dharma Sabha shall maintain general supervision over the business of the society and in particular over the acts of the Central Executive Committee & other Branch Committees and shall be competent to take steps that may be considered necessary in the interest of Dharma Sabha.
- (2) The business of the Annual General Meeting shall be:
 - (i) to consider the report of the Branch Committee President, General Secretary and Treasurer.
 - (ii) to consider audit report and audited statements of accounts.
 - (iii) to pass annual budget and the programs and activities of next year.
 - (iii) to elect members of the Central Executive Committee and such other officers as the meeting may think fit.
 - (iv) to appoint sub- committees, if necessary.
 - (v) to transact the meeting by the Central Executive Committee or Secretary.
- (3) Special Meeting and Extra Ordinary Meeting.
Special General Meeting and Extra Ordinary Meeting may be held at any time on any matter concerning Shri Krishna Pranami Dharma Sabha.
- (4) Requisition Meeting
 - (i) One third members of Central or Branch Committee may in writing call a requisition meeting by a letter signed by them addressed to the President to discuss and resolve any grave matter on concerning Dharma Sabha if no meeting is called for the purpose by the respective committee.
 - (ii) Within 21 days from the date of receipt of such notice, the President or the General Secretary shall be bound to call a meeting on the specific agenda.
 - (iii) In case no meeting is called by the President or General Secretary within 21 days from the data of receipt of such a notice, the requisition themselves may call a Requisition meeting on the specific agenda. No other business shall be transacted in such a meeting except specific agenda.
 - (a) Meeting of Executive Committee

Executive Committee meeting of Shri Krishna Pranami Dharma Sabha shall be held at least twice a year.
 - (b) Meeting of Branch Committee of Shri Krishna Pranami Dharma Sabha shall be held at least once every three months.

RULE 7

QUORUM

51% (fifty one percent) of the total members of Central Committee or Central Executive Committee or each Branch Committee shall form the quorum. However, one third of the members thereof shall be the quorum for any meeting adjourned due to insufficient quorum.

RULE 8

FINANCIAL & ACCOUNTS

(1) INCOME

Income of Shri Krishna Pranami Dharma Sabha may be raised follows:

- (a) Membership Fee.
- (b) Donations, grants, gifts, subsidies, and other receipts from the Government.
- (c) Any grant, gift, donation, subscription, assistance in cash or kind, movable or immovable from any person or persons or organisation whether Indian or Foreign.
- (d) Income derived from movable or immovable property or working of Dharma Sabha.
- (e) Loans.
- (f) Sri Krishna Pranami Dharma Sabha shall be the absolute owner of all movable or immovable properties derived from all sources as above. Books of accounts shall be maintained thereof.

(2) FUNDS

Separate fund shall be maintained for each Committee as follows:

Branch Committee:

- (a) 75% of the membership fee.
- (b) Offerings of Arati.
- (c) Donations, gifts and assistance received.
- (d) Receipt from Indian national- organisation or foreign individuals or organizations.
- (e) Government grant, subsidies, assistance and all other receipts.

Central Committee:

- (f) 25% of membership fee from each Branch Committee.
- (g) Offerings from Arati, annual Dhupbati.
- (h) Receipts from donations, gifts, assistance etc. From Indian national organisations of foreign individuals or organization.
- (i) Government grants, subsidies, assistance and all receipts.

(3) BANK ACCOUNT

- (a) Bank Account(s) shall be opened in the name of Shri Krishna Pranami Dharma Sabha in any Bank and all receipts from various sources shall be deposited in such Bank account(s).
- (b) Such Bank Account(s) shall be operated under the joint signatures of President or Secretary and Treasurer.
- (c) Books of account and all documents relating to income and expenditure shall be in the custody & responsibility of the Treasurer.

(4) AUDIT

- (a) Accounts of Shri Krishna Pranami Dharma Sabha shall be audited every year by competent auditors appointed by the Central Executive Committee.
- (b) Audited account of each Branch Committee and progress report shall be placed before the Central Committee every year.
- (c) Treasurer shall place report regarding the income and expenditure and accounts together with audited account in annual general meeting.

RULE 9

ELECTION

Election of respective committees of Sri Krishna Pranami Dharma Sabha shall be held as follows:

- (a) Central Committee before the expiration of its tenure shall request Advisory Board for nomination of one its member as a Returning Officer.
- (b) Branch Committee before the expiration of its tenure shall request Central Committee for nomination of one its member as a Returning Officer.
- (c) Returning Officer shall hold election on the basis of secret ballot.
- (d) Election for each Committee shall be held every 3(three) years.
- (e) If by any act of God, natural calamities, political/social/civil unrest or for any unforeseen reason or circumstances election of Central Committee is not held an Ad- hoc Central Committee shall be formed on the advice of Advisory Board for day today administration. However, such Ad- hoc Central Committee shall under no circumstances go beyond 6(six) other members of Central Executive Committee.

RULE 10

RELIGIOUS WORKERS

- (a) Acharya/ Guruji: Spiritual head of Sri Krishna Pranami Dharma Sabha will be known as Acharya who shall be a member of Executive Committee. Spiritual head of Kalimpong area shall always fill up the post of Acharya. Acharya shall have the absolute right to nominate 6 (six) other members of Central Executive Committee.
- (b) Dharma Pracharak : Sri Krishna Pranami Dharma Sabha shall have both Brahmachari and Grihastha Dharma Pracharak (religious propagators) in its service. Central Executive Committee at the recommendation of Acharya shall give recognition, approval and permission to such Dharma Pracharak to perform and observe seva- puja, arati and other services. Dharma Pracharak duly recognized and approved only shall

function within the jurisdiction of Shri Krishna Pranami Dharma Sabha. Dharma Pracharak shall be bound to abide by and uphold the rules & spiritual disciplines framed by Dharma Sabha.

- (c) Pujari : Pujari shall be in service in every Mandir of Dharma Sabha to perform & observe seva – puja, arati and other services both in Central Committee and Branch Committee. Such Pujari shall be appointed on the recommendation of Acharya by Central Executive Committee respectively. Pujari shall abide by and uphold the rules and regulation, code of conduct, moral & spiritual discipline as framed by Dharma Sabha.
- (d) Bhetia (Collector) : Acharya shall appoint Bhetia who will collect annual Offering (Bhetia) within the jurisdiction of Dharma Sabha. Central Executive Committee will fix the amount of Bheti.
- (e) In addition, all Santas, Mahatmas and other Sevaks shall be under Dharma Sabha within its jurisdiction.
- (f) Persons mentioned in clauses (a) to (e) shall have to be the ordinary members of Shri Krishna Pranami Dharma Sabha.

Responsibility of Dharma Sabha:

- (a) Dharma Sabha shall be responsible for and provide food and shelter for all engaged in religious works and services of Dharma Sabha as mentioned in Article 12 above.
- (b) Dharma Sabha shall look after and provide minimum needs, amenities and facilities to all Dharma Pracharaks and shall render medical aids and assistance in case of any ailment.
- (c) Dharma Sabha shall give proper advice from time to time to Dharma Pracharaks. It shall be the moral necessary help to Dharma Pracharaks to resolve their various problems and difficulties.

RULE 11

ADVISORY BOARD

Advisory Board of Dharma Sabha

In order to aid and advice, and for the promotion of Pranami Dharma Sabha following Advisory Board shall be constituted of the members of Pranami Society:

- (a) Advisory Board of Dharma Sabha shall consist of 5 (five) reputed Santa – Mahanta, devotees, elders and intellectuals.
- (b) Central Committee of Dharma Sabha shall nominate the members of Advisory Board for a period of 3 (three) years.
- (c) Advisory Board will aid and advice Dharma Sabha in framing it's policies and principles.
- (d) Advisory Board will organise various developmental projects and programmes for protection, preservation and development of Pranami Dharma.
- (e) Advisory Board will render aid and advice in all unresolved and complicated matters of Central Committee.
- (f) Meeting of Advisory Board shall be held at least twice a year.

RULE 12

RESIGNATION

- (a) Office bearer of Branch Committee shall submit his/ her resignation to it's President.
- (b) President of Branch Committee shall submit his/ her resignation to General Secretary of Central Committee.
- (c) Officer bearer of Central Committee shall submit his/ her resignation to President of Central Committee.
- (d) President of Central Committee shall submit his/her resignation to General Secretary of Central Committee.
- (e) Any resignation may be withdrawn at time before its accepted by the respective Committee.
- (f) Only on acceptance of resignation by the respective Committee , the Officers bearer shall be deemed to be relieve of his/her post and responsibilities.

- (g) Within 30 days from the date of receipt of resignation, a Special General meeting of resignation, a Special General Meeting of the respective Committee shall be called to consider and decide on specific agenda of resignation.

RULE 13

NO CONFIDENCE MOTION

- (a) Removal of any office bearer of any Committee for any reason shall be brought by a written "No Confidence Motion" signed by at least one third members of respective Committee, which will be submitted before it's Executive Committee through it's Secretary. Within 21 days from the date of receipt of such motion, the Executive Committee shall call a special meeting of Central Branch Committee concerned. Concerned office bearer may be removed from his/her post if the motion is passed and approved by two third majority of the said Committee. However, adequate opportunity of hearing shall be given to the concerned incumbent before such resolution of removal is passed.
- (b) No Confidence Motion against the President of Central Committee shall be submitted in writing to the General Secretary signed by at least one third of the members thereof. Within 21 days from the date of the receipt of such motion. Advisory Board shall call a meeting of Central Committee. The President may be removed from his post if the motion is passed and approved by two third majority of the total members present. However, adequate opportunity of hearing shall be given to the incumbent President before such a resolution of removal is passed.

RULE 14

AMENDMENT

- (a) Any proposal for amendment of the Memorandum of Association or Rules and Regulation of Dharma Sabha shall be Submitted in writing to the Central Committee.
- (b) Two third members of Central Committee may adopt a resolution for amendment of the Memorandum of Association or Rules and Regulation of Dharma Sabha.
- (c) Such resolution of Central Committee adopting amendment of the Memorandum of Association or Rules and Regulations of Dharma Sabha shall be placed in the Annual General Meeting of Dharma Sabha for approval. If approved by majority of the members present and voting, the amendment stands resolved and passed.
- (d) Amendment of the Memorandum of Association or Rules and Regulation of Dharma Sabha shall be subject to the provision of West Bengal Societies Registration Act 1961 and rules framed there under.

RULE 15

DISSOLUTION

Shri Krishna Pranami Dharma Sabha may be wound up by a resolution passed by three fourths of the members of Central Committee called for the purpose. In case of Dissolution of the society, it's movable & immovable properties, goodwill, assets, bank deposit, company shares, debentures, assets and Liabilities shall vest to other Pranami Organisations having same or similar objectives.
